#### Day 1: Tuesday, October 5, 2027 Overnight Flight

Travel overnight to Portugal, one of Europe's most hospitable countries. Here, you can enjoy a superb climate, historic sites, and beautiful scenery.

#### Day 2: Wednesday, October 6, 2027 Fatima, Portugal

Arrive in Fatima, Portugal's world-famous religious center. With no scheduled sightseeing today, spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. You may want to join the candlelight procession tonight.\*\* (D)

#### Day 3: Thursday, October 7, 2027 Fatima - Aljustrel -

**Fatima** You may celebrate Mass\* before traveling to Aljustrel, the quaint village of the three shepherd children to whom Our Lady appeared. Here, you can visit their humble homes and immerse yourself in the serene atmosphere of their daily lives. Continue to Valinhos, the site of the fifth apparition, where you can reflect on the profound events that took place. Later, return to Fatima\*\* to enjoy free time for personal worship and to explore the basilica and its grounds. (B, D)

#### Day 4: Friday, October 8, 2027 Fatima - Burgos, Spain

Attend a morning Mass\* before traveling along the long Pilgrim's Road to arrive in Burgos later this afternoon, a city that gracefully straddles the banks of the Rio Arlanzon. The slender, elegant spires of its famous cathedral rise majestically into the sky, a testament to its rich history and architectural splendor. In the evening, you may have the opportunity to attend another Mass,\* allowing for further reflection and spiritual enrichment. (B)

**Day 5: Saturday, October 9, 2027 Burgos** Join a local expert on a walking tour of Burgos' medieval town center. Spend time at Burgos Cathedral, a masterpiece of Spanish Gothic architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The cathedral, the third largest in Spain, offers such masterpieces as the filigree work in the spires of the towers, the starry dome, the choir, the sarcophagi, and the golden staircase. Next, visit a monastery and learn about monastic life and architecture. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore at your leisure, or you may choose to join a short hike along the Saint James Way. Mass\* is available this evening. (B, L)

**Day 6: Sunday, October 10, 2027 Burgos - Lourdes, France** Today, travel northeast on a long, scenic drive through the Pyrenees Mountains. As the landscape shifts from the vast Castilian plains to dramatic mountain passes, enjoy the changing views and natural beauty of this iconic region. Lourdes is the sacred place in the Grotto of Massabielle where the Virgin Mary appeared to the poor shepherd girl Bernadette eighteen times between February 11 and July 16, 1858. Since then, this once-quiet market town has become one of the world's most important pilgrimage destinations, welcoming millions each year. Tonight, you may wish to partake in a candlelight procession.\*\* (B, D)

**Day 7: Monday, October 11, 2027 Lourdes** After morning Mass,\* enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes, visiting

the places associated with the life of St. Bernadette: the "Boly Mill" (her birthplace), the "Cachot" (the former prison where she and her family lived), and the parish church housing the saint's baptismal font. Later, enjoy some time at leisure to explore the town's rich historical and natural heritage. Immerse yourself in the sacred atmosphere of the apparitions and embrace the enduring spirit of unity and devotion that continues to define Lourdes today. (B, D)

**Day 8: Tuesday, October 12, 2027 Lourdes - Barcelona, Spain** Celebrate Mass\* before crossing back into Spain on your way to Barcelona, one of Europe's most fascinating cities. Prepare yourself for a long journey through Spain's beautiful scenery. On the way, enjoy a stop at the quaint mountain village of Montserrat, visit the basilica,\*\* and enjoy some reflection time to admire this sacred place. Upon arrival, get your first taste of this vibrant city with a walk around the area of your hotel. (B)

**Day 9: Wednesday, October 13, 2027 Barcelona** This morning, discover Barcelona on a guided tour that

highlights the city's vibrant character and architectural treasures. With your local guide, stroll through the narrow medieval streets of the Gothic Quarter and uncover hidden plazas, centuries-old façades, and stories that shaped the city. Here, step inside the majestic Barcelona Cathedral, a shining example of Gothic devotion, and feel the peaceful atmosphere that has welcomed pilgrims for over 700 years. Your city tour concludes around 1:00 p.m., leaving you free to enjoy the city at your own pace. You might decide to visit the Sagrada Família independently,\*\*\* stroll through the historic avenues, seek quiet moments in one of the city's many chapels, or simply take time for personal prayer and contemplation. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for dinner to celebrate the end of your spiritual tour. (B, D)

**Day 10: Thursday, October 14, 2027 Barcelona - Tour Ends** Return home eager to share vivid memories of a beautiful land with an old, rich, and diverse cultural heritage. (B)

**The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2.** This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

### ***Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).***

During our Barcelona walking tour in the Gothic Quarter, expect to walk around 1 mile on cobblestone streets, and uphill at times.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

We are visiting medieval towns with steep, uneven, cobblestone ground, and stairs and steps are everywhere.

As this tour travels to 3 countries, expect 3 days of long coach transfers.

It's important to keep in mind that this tour covers significant overland distances, crossing through Portugal, Spain, France, and returning again into Spain. Some days will include up to eight hours of travel by coach, allowing us to take in the changing landscapes along the way.

From Fatima to Burgos, we will travel approximately 394 miles (634 kilometers).

From Burgos to Lourdes, we will travel approximately 253 miles (407 kilometers).

From Lourdes to Barcelona, we will travel approximately 272 miles (438 kilometers).

\*\*\*Viewing the Black Madonna requires the purchase of an additional ticket, subject to availability. Travelers can purchase tickets onsite, but these may sell out during peak travel seasons.

\*\*In Fatima and Lourdes, there is a candlelight procession every night at 9:00 p.m. or 9:30 p.m. from April to November.

\*Mass is subject to availability and may not be offered in English.

\*\*\*\*If you plan to visit the Sagrada Família or other major monuments, we recommend purchasing your tickets at least 30 days in advance and scheduling your visit for this afternoon.

Breakfasts in Lourdes are Continental.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Due to traffic regulations, motorcoaches cannot reach historic city centers. This means at times, the coach may drop the group off at one location but

pick it up elsewhere. If you opt out of an activity, you'll need to arrange your own transfer to the next coach pick-up spot, as travelers cannot remain on the coach during stops due to European regulations.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our transfers will depart from Lisbon airport for Fatima. Travel time from Lisbon to Fatima is approximately 2 hours.

Our air travelers will arrive at Lisbon, Portugal airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Due to tour scheduling, arrival flights should arrive prior to 2:00 p.m.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.
